This is done by shapes that show up on your image.¹

| Do you have a <u>raised mole</u> on your breast? | Ask for the circle.  |
| Do you <u>feel a mass or lump</u> in your breast? | Ask for the triangle.  |
| Do you have a <u>scar from a prior surgery</u> on your breast? | Ask for the line.  |
| Do you have an <u>area on the breast that is painful</u> or you are concerned about? | Ask for the square.  |
